Thanks to the generosity of community members, business owners, and GHS alumni, the GPSF has been able to support enriching educational opportunities in CUSD #205 since 1987! Over the past 10 years alone, we have granted almost \$300,000 to support a wide range of requests from educators, principals, and district administrators. GPSF funds have supported reading, writing, technology, the fine arts, physical education, accelerated learning, accessibility, and social/emotional learning. We also have granted funds to teachers to attend training events and have supported staff wellness programs.

Since January of 2023, we have supported CUSD #205 students and staff by providing funds for:

- ◆ Choose to Thrive in #205 (staff wellness event)
